**Definitions:**

1. "↔" means directional "between." Travel may originate in either direction.
2. "→" means directional "to." Travel must originate in the direction indicated.
3. "Fare Class" means the first character of the Fare Basis, which determines the applicability of a discount.
4. "Geographical Entity(ies)" means the specific countries, regions, territories, continents, or other defined locations that determine the applicability of a discount for a specific term.
5. "Marketing Carrier" means the Carrier whose code appears on a ticket.
6. "Non-Hub" means any airport that isn't an OA Hub or UA Hub.
7. "OA Hub" means "Other Airline Hub" and refers to the following airports, each designated by three-letter IATA airport code: Atlanta, GA (ATL); Boston, MA (BOS); Charlotte, NC (CLT); Washington, DC (DCA); Dallas, TX (DFW); Detroit, MI (DTW); New York, NY (JFK)<sup>1</sup>; New York, NY (LGA); Miami, FL (MIA); Minneapolis, MN (MSP); Philadelphia, PA (PHL); Phoenix, AZ (PHX); Seattle, WA (SEA); and Salt Lake City, UT (SLC).
8. "Operating Carrier" means a Carrier having operational control of the aircraft for a specific flight.
9. "Point of Origin" ("POO") means the initial country or region of departure as indicated on a ticket.
10. "Point of Sale" ("POS") means the location where a ticket is issued, identified by a specific country or region.
11. "UA Hub" means "United Airlines Hub" and refers to the following airports, each designated by three-letter IATA airport code: Chicago, IL (ORD); Denver, CO (DEN); Houston, TX (IAH); Los Angeles, CA (LAX); Newark, NJ (EWR); San Francisco, CA (SFO); and Washington, DC (IAD).
12. "Validating Carrier" means the Carrier that issues a ticket.

Note: (1) New York (JFK) is designated as an OA Hub under this Commercial Offer. As of the beginning of the Term, United does not currently serve JFK; however, United reserves the right to resume service to JFK in the future.

### **Ticketing Terms & General Conditions:**

**Eligibility:** Discounts apply solely to travel associated with this “Qualifying Event” and are not intended for individual corporate or leisure travel.

**Authorized Distribution Channels:** Tickets may be issued through the United Customer Contact Center, United’s direct channels (including, but not limited to, united.com and the United mobile app), or an authorized Travel Management Company (“**Agency**”) (each, an “**Authorized Distribution Channel**”). Tickets are subject to the general fare conditions published in the GDS or any other Authorized Distribution Channel. United reserves the right to add or remove Authorized Distribution Channels at any time.

**Eligible Flights:** Only the flights listed below, operated under valid carrier combinations and routings that comply with all applicable booking class, Point of Origin, and Point of Sale restrictions and that are ticketed within the designated Ticketing Dates and flown within the designated Travel Dates to which a Discount applies, shall be considered an “Eligible Flight” under this Commercial Offer:

- **United Flights:** Flights operated by United or operated by other carriers and operating as United Express (“UA”).
- **Canada Point of Sale:** Flights operated and marketed by United and United codeshare flights operated by Air Canada (“AC”), Austrian Airlines (“OS”), Brussels Airlines N.V. (“SN”), Deutsche Lufthansa AG (“LH”), Swiss International Air Lines Ltd. (“LX”), All Nippon Airways Co., Ltd. (“NH”).
- **Online Bookings via United’s Direct Channels:** Flights operated and marketed by United and United codeshare flights operated by Air Canada (“AC”), Austrian Airlines (“OS”), Brussels Airlines N.V. (“SN”), Deutsche Lufthansa AG (“LH”), Swiss International Air Lines Ltd. (“LX”), All Nippon Airways Co., Ltd. (“NH”).

In the event of any inconsistency between this section and the terms of an individual Discount, the terms of the individual Discount shall govern. Notwithstanding any alternative carrier combinations or routings selected, Discounts shall apply only to through fares operated under these approved carrier combinations and routings.

### **Fares:**

- Fare Basis refers to the first letter of the published base fare.
- Fares do not include taxes or fees, including but not limited to carrier surcharges, international fees or any similar surcharges or fees indicated in the YQ and/or YR ticketing field.
- Rebooking, cancellation, refund, buy-up to a higher fare, stopovers, rerouting, reissue, or taxes and surcharges are per fare rule.
- Class differential calculations are not permitted. When the international overwater segment (e.g., from the origin country’s international gateway to the destination country’s international gateway) is flown in first class, the applicable first class through fare applies. Likewise, when the international overwater segment is flown in business class, the applicable business class through fare applies.

### **Discounts:**

- Discounts are non-commissionable (including any retroactive commissions) and may not be combined with other discounts.
- Discount applicability is determined using the first character of the Fare Basis.
- Discounts are not permitted on Basic Economy fares, including fare types EOU, ERU, ERS, or ERT.
- Discounts are not combinable with fares offered through any other incentive, certificate, promotional, or other discount program.
- Discounts do not apply to taxes or fees, including but not limited to carrier surcharges, international fees, or any similar charges or fees indicated in the YQ and/or YR ticketing fields.
- Discounts do not apply to the purchase of United travel add-ons or bundles.
- Discounts are not retroactive.
- All published fares with a fare basis not explicitly addressed in this Commercial Offer shall receive a zero percent (0%) discount.

### **Ticketing Options:**

- Eligible Travelers originating in the U.S. 50 States and Canada may ticket through an Agency, United’s direct channels (including the event specific booking URL or united.com/meetingtravel, or the United Customer Contact Center.

- Eligible Travelers may access an event-specific booking URL with the embedded Z Code associated with the applicable meeting. - **Additional Agency ticketing requirements:**
  - Discounts are not permitted on Basic Economy fares, including fares associated with fare types EOU, ERU, ERS, and ERT.
  - It is the responsibility of Agency to test and ensure that pricing, the account code, Tour Code, and Ticket Designator are correctly applied per these ticketing instructions. If discrepancies are identified, United must be notified within one (1) week of the implementation of this Commercial Offer; otherwise, Agency assumes responsibility for all errors and/or omissions.
  - Debit memos may be issued for tickets that include invalid or missing Tour Codes or that otherwise fail to comply with the above requirements.

### **Miscellaneous Terms and Conditions:**

- Termination and Amendments: United may terminate or amend this Agreement at any time upon ten (10) days' prior written notice. If any such amendment is unacceptable to Travel Leaders Headquarters (customer) may terminate this Agreement upon at least five (5) days' prior written notice to United. United reserves the right to terminate this Agreement and cancel any associated reservations immediately on written notice, if United reasonably determines that ticketing pursuant to this Agreement is not in connection with this bona fide meeting/event.
- Trademarks and Logos: Travel Leaders (customer) shall NOT use any trade name, logo or service mark of United without first obtaining United's written approval of such use.
- Confidentiality: Travel Leaders (customer) shall NOT disclose to any third party this Agreement or any terms or conditions of this Agreement without the prior written consent of United, except for Travel Leaders (customer's) travel agency. Any breach of confidentiality will immediately render this Agreement null and void. Airline carriers included in this Agreement may disclose to each other Travel Leaders (Customer name), Z code, travel destination and validity of this Agreement.
- Non-Assignment: Travel Leaders (customer) shall NOT assign this Agreement or any right or obligation hereunder without the prior written consent of United.
- Non-Waiver: The right of United to require strict performance and observance of any of Travel Leaders (customer's) obligations hereunder shall NOT be affected in any way by any previous waiver, forbearance or course of dealing. Exercise by United of its right to terminate hereunder will in no way affect or impair its right to bring suite for any Travel Leaders (customer) default or breach of this Agreement.
- Exclusion of Consequential Damages: United will not be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages, including lost revenues, lost profits, or lost prospective economic advantage, whether or not foreseeable and whether or not based on contract, tort, or warranty claims or otherwise, arising from any performance or failure to perform under this Agreement, and Travel Leaders (customer) hereby releases and waives any claims against United regarding such damages.
- Indemnification: Travel Leaders (customer) will indemnify and hold harmless United and its officers, directors, employees, and agents (the "Indemnities") from and against any and all liabilities, damages, losses, expenses, claims, demands, suits, fines, or judgments, including but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees, costs, and related expenses, which may be suffered by, accrue against, or be recovered from any of the Indemnities resulting from or arising out of or in connection with: (i) any breach by Travel Leaders (customer) of any of its obligations under this Agreement; or (ii) any negligence or intentional or willful misconduct of Travel Leaders (customer) in connection with this Agreement. The indemnity and hold harmless obligations of Travel Leaders (customer) pursuant to this section are of a continuing nature and will survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.
- Force Majeure/Delay: Neither United or Travel Leaders (customer) will be responsible for delays or failure in performance caused by acts of God or governmental authority, strike or labor dispute, or for any other cause, whether similar or dissimilar, beyond the reasonable control of that party whose performance is affected. Notwithstanding the foregoing, United will not be liable to Travel Leaders (customer) for, and Travel Leaders (customer) hereby releases and waives any and all claims against United for any flight cancellation, schedule change, or other failure to accommodate any passenger arising under this Agreement.
- Governing Law: This Agreement and any dispute arising under or in connection with this Agreement, including any action in tort, shall be governed and construed by the laws of the State of Illinois, U.S.A., without regard to any conflicts of law principles which may direct the application of laws of any other jurisdiction.
- Rules Governing Tickets: All air transportation tickets issued by Travel Leaders (customer) hereunder or otherwise shall be subject to (a) the terms and conditions of this Agreement (b) the applicable carrier's Contract of Carriage; and (c) any rules and tariffs applicable to the general public for the class of fare purchased by passenger. Tickets may not be issued or used within any governmental, regulatory or taxing jurisdiction in which such issuances or use violates any tariff, law, order, regulation or taxation policy. Travel Leaders (customer) hereby acknowledges that actions such as, but not limited to, hidden-city ticketing, beyond-point ticketing, back-to-back ticketing, cross-border ticketing, fraud, speculative or abusive bookings and issuing tickets under this Agreement to individuals who do not qualify as a passenger are in violation of the Contract of Carriage and this Agreement. If Travel Leaders (customer) engages in any such prohibited activity or fraud, United may terminate this Agreement immediately upon written notice to Travel Leaders (customer) and any benefits earned by not used by Travel Leaders (customer) under the terms of this Agreement will be forfeited. Travel Leaders (customer) agrees to return any unused, forfeited benefits to United upon United's written request. Travel Leaders (customer) shall be responsible and/or liable for any violations for tickets issued that violate the terms and conditions of this Agreement, United's Contract of Carriage or the fare rules or tariffs applicable to the fare issued by Travel Leaders (customer).
- No Joint and Several Liability: In no event will any party be held jointly and/or severally liable for any actions of any other party or all of the other parties.
